PARADE ROUTE

Route forms at 7th Street and 6th, 5th and 4th Avenues.

Proceed North on 7th Street to East State Street.

Turn West on East State Street

CONTINUE on East State Street, crossing the bridge and passing Wyman and Main Streets.

Disband at Church Street.

PLEASE NOTE

- 7th Street will be CLOSED to parade traffic
- Please use 6th Street South (one way) and 9th Street South (one way) to reach your assigned Parade Division. If you move an unmanned barricade, put it back once through.

THROWING candy or objects is **NOT PERMITTED.**

If you throw candy or any items, you will be removed from the parade immediately and fined from the Police Department.

Handing out candy is permitted.

Parade Rules

- The Rockford 4th of July Civic Committee reserves the right to not approve any application.
 - Approved applications will receive an **email** showing approval and their division information.
- **THROWING** of any objects from your float/vehicle along the parade route will **not** be permitted. Objects are defined, but not limited to, **candy**, political propaganda, etc. If you are seen throwing anything, you will be removed from the parade route.
 - *Candy handed out along the sides of the parade route **is** permitted. No Throwing.*
- Your parade unit must be of a patriotic nature. Occult or non-patriotic units will not be permitted in the parade.
 - 60,000 – 80,000 people are expected along the parade route...Impress them with your creativity!
 - You must submit the concept of your vehicle/float along with this application.
 - A Trophy will be awarded for '**Best Patriotic Float**'
 - 2019 Trophy was awarded to 'Just Breath 815' Parade Float
 - 2021 Trophy was awarded to 'Comfort 1st Insulation' Parade Float
 - 2022 Trophy was award to 'Comfort 1st Insulation' Parade Float
- Signs that insult, belittle or embarrass any individual or organization will not be allowed to be carried or displayed as part of your parade unit.
- Active political campaigning will not be allowed in any division other than the division that is termed "Political Division."
 - **Each politician must pay an entry fee to march/float in the parade. Please see fees on page 1.**
- Street vendors must have a special permit and have it displayed to sell goods along the parade route.
- We are all Americans celebrating the birth of this great nation! **Let's all have a great time!**
