

 - Approved applications will receive an email showing approval and their division information.
- **THROWING** of any objects from your float/vehicle along the parade route will **not** be permitted. Objects are defined, but not limited to, **candy**, political propaganda, etc. If you are seen throwing <u>anything</u>, you will be removed from the parade route.
 - Candy <u>handed out</u> along the <u>sides</u> of the parade route <u>is</u> permitted. **No**
 Throwing.
- Your parade unit must be of a <u>patriotic</u> nature. Occult or non-patriotic units will not be permitted in the parade.
 - 60,000 80,000 people are expected along the parade route...Impress them with your creativity!
 - We are celebrating our country and our community. If you do not want to follow the rules of decorating, then please do not apply.
 - o You must submit the concept of your vehicle/float along with this application.
 - Any group that doesn't show any festive decorations pertaining to Independence
 Day will not be allowed to partake in the parade.
 - A Trophy will be awarded for 'Best Patriotic Float'
- Signs that insult, belittle or embarrass any individual or organization will not be allowed to be carried or displayed as part of your parade unit.
- Active political campaigning will not be allowed in any division other than the division that is termed "Political Division."
 - Each politician must pay an entry fee to march/float in the parade. Please see fees on page 1.
